Buses remain on snow routes

NASHVILLE – WeGo Public Transit buses will remain operating on snow routes through Friday afternoon. Snow routes are for routes that need to use a detour to navigate safely during inclement weather. Buses will operate on all routes that have weekday service, even if a snow route detour is not listed for a particular route.

Route 4 is operating on a modified snow detour, and routes 14, 41, 42, 84, 86, 87, 88, 89, 94, and 95 are not operating at this time.

WeGo Access is operating, but paratransit customers are advised to prepare for possible delays as drivers will be proceeding with caution through neighborhoods. The Customer Information Booth at WeGo Central will close at 3 p.m. today. The Call Center will remain open until 8 p.m.

Safety is our number one priority, so please be aware that there may be additional delays as bus operators are proceeding cautiously. We ask that you allow for additional travel time so we can help get you where you need to go safely.
