## Buses to remain on snow routes through Saturday morning

**NASHVILLE** – WeGo Public Transit buses will continue to operate on snow route detours through Saturday morning. Snow routes are for routes that need to use a detour to navigate safely during inclement weather. Buses will operate on all routes that have service, even if a snow route detour is not listed for a particular route.

Route 4 is operating on a modified snow detour, and routes 14, 41, 42, 84, and 86, will not run today. A decision will be made mid-morning Saturday as to when buses on routes 14 and 42 will return to service.

WeGo Access is operating, but paratransit customers are advised to prepare for possible delays as drivers will be proceeding with caution through neighborhoods.

Safety is our number one priority, so please be aware that there may be additional delays as bus operators are proceeding cautiously. We ask that you allow for additional travel time so we can help get you where you need to go safely.
