## WeGo offering Nashville SC Express pilot bus service

**NASHVILLE** – WeGo Public Transit and the Nashville Soccer Club are partnering to offer a pilot express bus service to soccer fans needing transportation to four NSC home games.

Buses will stop at two park-and-ride locations – Old Fort Park in Murfreesboro and the Hickory Hollow stop located at the Global Mall in Antioch. Service will operate for the September 30, October 4, October 14, and October 21 games.

Cost is \$8.50 for a round trip ticket and available through the QuickTicket fare payment system, which can be found at [QuickTicketTN.com](http://QuickTicketTN.com). Fans should purchase two "1-Ride Express Bus Passes" to cover their round trip fare on their QuickTicket card or phone app. Parking is free at both park-and-ride lots. The drop-off and pick-up location at GEODIS Park will be on Wedgewood Avenue near parking lot 11. All WeGo buses are ADA compliant.

For the September 30, October 4, and October 14 games, the Nashville SC express will operate the schedule listed below:

- Depart from Old Fort Park 5:50 p.m.
- Depart from Hickory Hollow 6:15 p.m.
- Arrive at Geodis Park 6:45 p.m.

For the October 21 game, the Nashville SC express will operate the schedule listed below:

- Depart from Old Fort Park 3:20 p.m.
- Depart from Hickory Hollow 3:45 p.m.
- Arrive at Geodis Park 4:15 p.m.

The return trip will depart 30 minutes after the game ends for all games. Details can be found at [wegotransit.com](http://wegotransit.com).

Nashville SC fans can continue to use regular service WeGo buses to attend all home games.
