WeGo partners with Railway Museum for Rail Safety Week

NASHVILLE – Governor Bill Lee has proclaimed September 17- 23 Rail Safety Week in Tennessee. WeGo Public Transit is reminding people to be careful around trains. As part of the Operation Lifesaver awareness program, the Tennessee Central Railway Museum will bring a special train car featuring the Safety Caboose to Riverfront Station in downtown Nashville on September 21 and 22 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Museum volunteers will be on-site talk to visitors about rail safety and a television will show Operation Lifesaver videos. Riverfront Station is located at 108 First Ave South. Parking is available across the street from the station.
