Community encouraged to help “stuff the WeGo bus” *Food drive at WeGo Central and Green Hills Mall*

NASHVILLE – WeGo Public Transit will collect canned goods at WeGo Central now thru Dec. 22 from 5:30 a.m. until 5:30 p.m. for the Second Harvest Food Bank of Middle Tennessee. Food donations can be dropped at 400 Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. at a van inside Central on the 4th Avenue level. Customers donating food items Dec. 15 and 22 will receive a 1-Ride bus ticket while supplies last.

Canned goods are also being collected within an on-site van at The Mall at Green Hills on Dec. 18 and 23 from noon to 4 p.m. Guests are encouraged to climb aboard, get a photo behind the wheel and receive a WeGo cookie. Renderings about the Hillsboro Transit Center are also on display. The WeGo van will be parked at the Mall entrance, located between The Container Store and Restoration Hardware.
