WeGo to operate Sunday/Holiday schedule on Labor Day Regional buses, WeGo Star will not operate

NASHVILLE – On Monday, September 5, 2022, WeGo Public Transit will operate its buses and Access vans on a Sunday/Holiday schedule in observance of Labor Day. Regional commuter bus and WeGo Star commuter rail will not be in service. WeGo administrative offices, including the Customer Care Call Center and WeGo Central Ticket window, will be closed on Labor Day.
