WeGo reducing service for remainder of evening

Four routes cut due to worsening road conditions, others proceeding with caution

NASHVILLE – Effective 8:15 p.m., WeGo Public Transit is halting service on the following routes due to icy road conditions:

- 19 Herman
- 25 Midtown
- 28 Meridian
- 29 Jefferson

The remaining buses in service this evening will continue to operate through end of service as long as road conditions permit safe operation. Safety is our number one priority, so please be aware that there may be additional delays as bus operators are proceeding cautiously. We ask that you allow for additional travel time so we can help get you where you need to go safely.

Reminder that on Monday, February 15, 2021, WeGo will begin service [with all snow detours](#) in effect within Davidson County.
