WeGo buses operating on snow detours

NASHVILLE – Due to winter weather, WeGo Public Transit buses are operating on snow route detours. Route 4 is operating modified service to Shelby & 19th, and routes 6, 14, 19, 22B, 29, 41, 42, and 75 will not run due to icy conditions. Regional buses operated by Gray Line (routes 87, 88, 89, 94, and 95) will not operate.

Snow routes are for routes that need to use a detour to navigate safely during inclement weather. Buses will operate on all routes that have weekday service, even if a snow route detour is not listed for a particular route.

Safety is our number one priority, so please be aware that there may be additional delays as bus operators are proceeding cautiously. We ask that you allow for additional travel time so we can help get you where you need to go safely.
