## WeGo service changes go into effect April 3 Riders offered route extensions, improved frequency & more late-night trips on select routes

**NASHVILLE** – Effective Sunday, April 3, 2022, WeGo Public Transit will implement system-wide service changes that include more frequent buses on local routes during peak times, route extensions, and more latenight trip choices. In addition, a new route 79 Skyline offers a connection between Gallatin Pike/Madison and Dickerson Pike, providing service to residential areas on Dickerson north of Briley Parkway. These changes reflect customer input and community feedback.
