WeGo to run buses along Star train route on Tuesday, March 22 Due to continued clean-up efforts, regular train will not operate

NASHVILLE – Due to a freight train derailment in Mt. Juliet, WeGo Public Transit will operate buses between WeGo Star stations on Tuesday, March 22, 2022, to accommodate train passengers instead of its regular train service.

For Wilson County riders, a bus will depart Lebanon at 5:40 a.m. and 6:35 a.m. and stop in Hamilton Springs, Martha, and Mt. Juliet en route to Riverfront Station. Davidson County riders will board a route 6 Lebanon Pike bus to Riverfront Station. Riders may experience delays.

The 64 Star Downtown Shuttle and 93 Star West End Shuttle will be timed to meet all a.m. riders at Riverfront.

In the afternoon, route 93 buses will operate on a modified schedule, with pick ups at 21st & West End at 3:47 p.m. and 4:29 p.m. route 64 buses will depart from 7th & Harrison at 3:57 p.m. and 4:42 p.m.

For the return trip from Nashville, buses will depart Riverfront Station at 4:20 p.m. and 5:10 p.m. and stop at all stations.

Clean-up is continuing along the tracks, and regular train service will resume once the tracks are clear. Check our social media accounts and website for updates.
