Mt. Juliet Train Station Meeting, March 26

RTA proposes to expand parking, add customer amenities, safety features

NASHVILLE – On March 26, the Regional Transportation Authority of Middle Tennessee will hold a public meeting to discuss a proposed expansion of the Mt. Juliet Train Station parking lot for residents and riders of the Music City Star.

RTA Staff will share information about improvements and additional amenities, including 100-110 parking spaces, pathways to Mt. Juliet Road and Division Street, bicycle racks, added lighting, and beautification.

The Regional Transportation Authority of Middle Tennessee has provided regional rail service between Lebanon and Nashville since September 18, 2008. The Music City Star makes six daily trips between Lebanon and downtown Nashville Monday through Friday. The Music City Star is responsible for transporting approximately 1,100 commuters to and from work each weekday.

The Mt. Juliet train station sees approximately 185 passenger boardings on an average weekday, and is the highest ridership station along the Music City Star route.
