Update on Temporary Boarding Locations for Star passengers

NASHVILLE – As a reminder, the building serving Riverfront Station is closed for the upcoming NFL Draft and boarding activities for regular weekday commuter rail passengers from downtown Nashville will be as follows:

- **April 8-23**, Riverfront passengers will board from a temporary location under the **Pedestrian Bridge**.
 - To access the temporary platform beneath the Pedestrian Bridge, customers must take Demonbreun to cross over 1st Avenue South.
- **April 24-26**, Riverfront passengers will board from a temporary platform located at **Ascend Amphitheatre**.
 - To access the temporary platform at Ascend Amphitheatre, customers must take Demonbreun, Molloy, or Korean Veterans Blvd. Signage will be in place to direct customers to the platform.

Note: No trains will be held for morning or afternoon service on April 24-26. Buses will be available along Korean Veterans Blvd during afternoon train service hours to accommodate passengers **after the last train departs**. These buses will take Star passengers to all train stations. Further details to come.
