Holiday Service to include multiple routes, special event train Downtown

NASHVILLE – This Independence Day, WeGo Public Transit bus service will operate on Sunday/Holiday service hours and run the Star's annual July 4th train. These services help residents and visitors safely celebrate the Let Freedom Sing! Celebration. WeGo Bus

All routes will operate on a Sunday/Holiday schedule. Service on select routes will be extended to get customers home after the fireworks – normal fares apply.

Regular service buses on all bus routes will depart WeGo Central at 9:15 p.m. At the conclusion of the fireworks display, select routes will have a single departure at 10:45 p.m. from Broadway in front of Hume-Fogg Magnet School (between 7th and 8th Avenues):

Round-trip tickets cost \$15 plus a \$0.88 processing fee and are available for purchase at <u>ticketsnashville.com</u>. Tickets will be on sale until 24 hours prior to departure or until they are sold out, whichever comes first. Tickets will not be sold at the train stations. Customers will receive one ticket for the round-trip and must show the ticket when boarding to receive a colored wristband for return trip train ticket. Children age 4 and younger will not need a ticket to board but are required to sit in a parent or guardian's lap. The return train to Lebanon leaves 45 minutes after the conclusion of the Nashville fireworks. Weekday Music City Star tickets and monthly passes are not accepted on the July 4th train.
