WeGo to operate Sunday/Holiday schedule on New Year's Day Regional buses, Star commuter rail will not operate

NASHVILLE – On Wednesday, January 1, 2020, WeGo Public Transit will operate its buses and Access vans on a Sunday/Holiday schedule in observance of New Year's Day. Regional commuter buses and the WeGo Star will not be in service. WeGo's administrative offices will be closed.

All WeGo services, except for the Star commuter train, will operate regular service schedules on New Year's Eve, Tuesday, December 31.

Note on Star Service: Due to federal regulations, the WeGo Star will have limited service to and from downtown Nashville on the morning of Tuesday, December 31 only in order to operate the New Year's Eve Express special event train later that evening.

Affected trips include the 7:45 a.m. departure from Mt. Juliet to Nashville (Train 154) and the 8:25 a.m. departure from Nashville to Lebanon (Train 155). These last morning trips to and from Nashville will not operate as regularly scheduled, nor will they accept passengers.

All other morning and afternoon trains will operate as scheduled on December 31.
