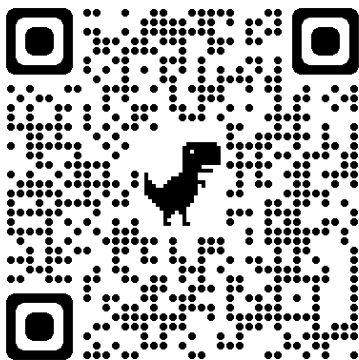
WeGo is proposing frequency improvements, routing adjustments, route renumbering, and previously Board approved return to pre-COVID-19 service levels on most routes as well as later Access On Demand service to be **effective April 3, 2022**.

Impacted routes that may be renumbered, extended, or modified include: **3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 14, 17, 19, 21, 22, 23, 25, 28, 29, 42, 50, 52, 55, 56, 76, 77, 87, 88, 89, 94, 95, and Access On Demand**.
