


Distinguish Connector Routes

- No service on Ardee between Gallatin Pike & Kennedy.





- Restore to 100% pre-pandemic service hours
 - Route 87 Gallatin/Hendersonville
 - Route 88 Dickson
 - Route 89 Springfield/Joelton
 - Route 94 Clarksville
 - Route 95 Spring Hill/Franklin

Additional Approved Changes

- Route 79 Skyline
 - To serve Dickerson Pike north of Walmart
 - To connect Dickerson Pike with Gallatin Pike
- Fare capping—currently in effect
 - When using QuickTicket more than twice a day, users won't be charged for additional rides that day
 - QuickTicket users paying daily throughout the month won't be charged for trips beyond the cost of a monthly pass
