Recent Service Accomplishments

Increased ridership

- In 2025, WeGo provided more than 9 million rides

Introduction of Journey Pass Program

- Over 9,000 registrations
- More than 760,000 free transit trips
- More than 60 registration events

Service improvements

- Increased frequency midday, evenings, and weekends on several routes
- Expanded Access on Demand to weekends and holidays
- Expanded WeGo Link with new zones
- Added and upgraded several bus stops



Route 18 Airport


Frequency Improvements

- Weekdays and weekends
 - Improve to every 30 minutes
 - » 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
 - Every 40 minutes evenings



Route 18 Airport (cont.)

- Route adjustments
 - To improve reliability, the bus will no longer travel on Acorn Drive and Massman Drive and bus stops on this segment will be removed.
 - The bus will no longer travel on Elm Hill Pike between Arlington Avenue and Murfreesboro Pike. Bus stops along this segment will be removed.



MNPS Routing Changes



- **Creswell Middle School**

Route 76 Madison & 79 Skyline


On-Time Performance

- An additional vehicle will be added to improve on-time performance and reliability




WeGo Link




