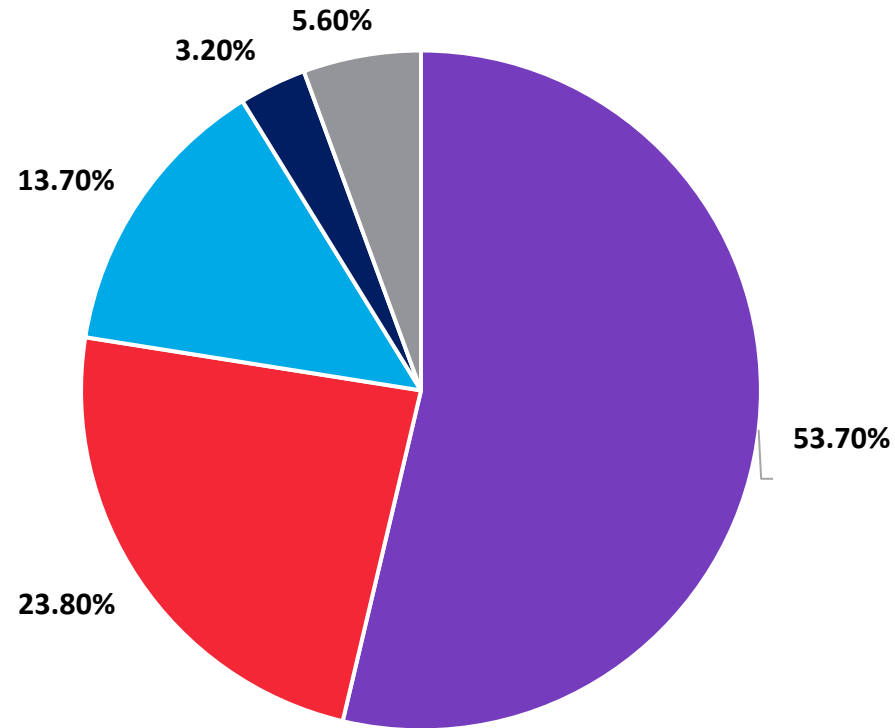


What is Title VI?

- Prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color or national origin in programs or activities receiving federal financial assistance.
- Agency Goals:
 - Ensure that the level and quality of public transportation services is provided in a nondiscriminatory manner;
 - Promote full and fair participation in public transportation decision-making without regard to race, color, or national origin; and
 - Ensure meaningful access to transit-related programs and activities by persons with limited English proficiency.

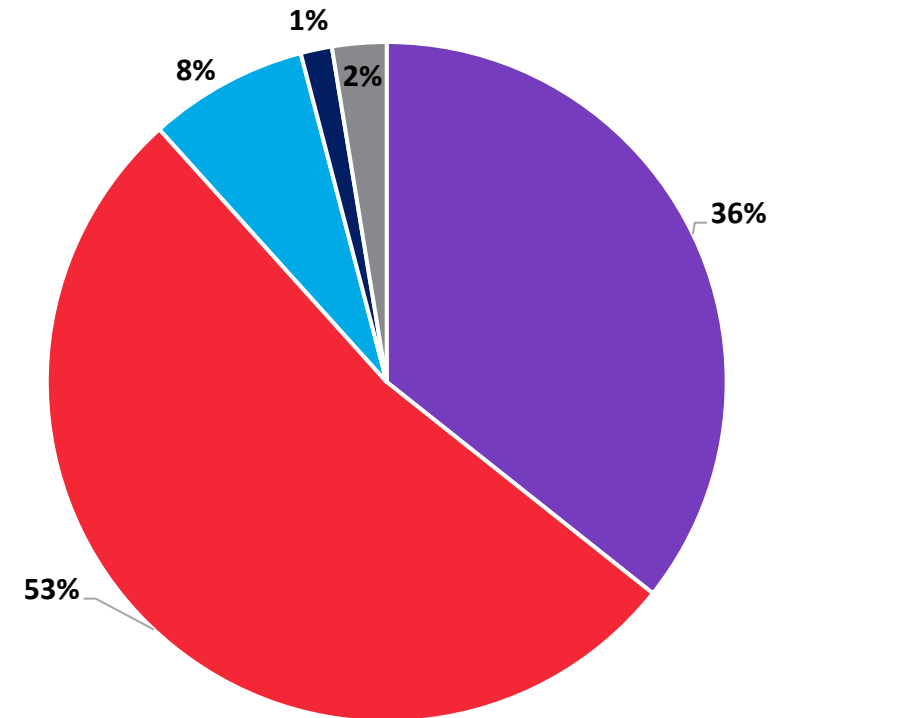
Demographic Profiles of the MTA Service Area

Demographics of MTA Ridership

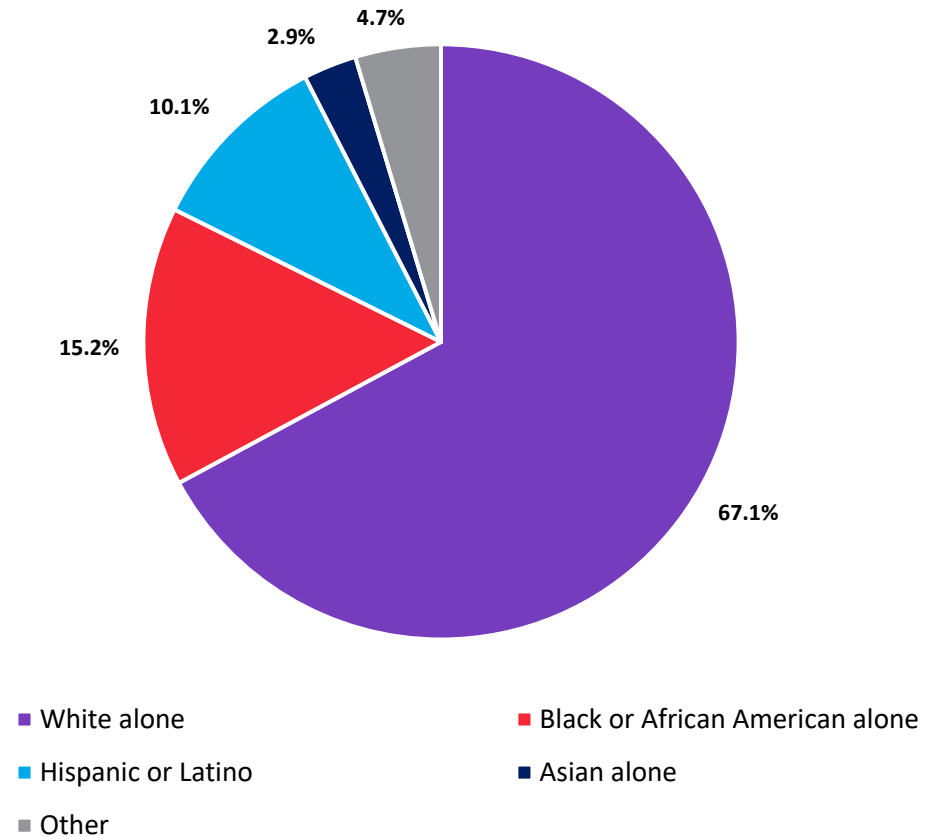

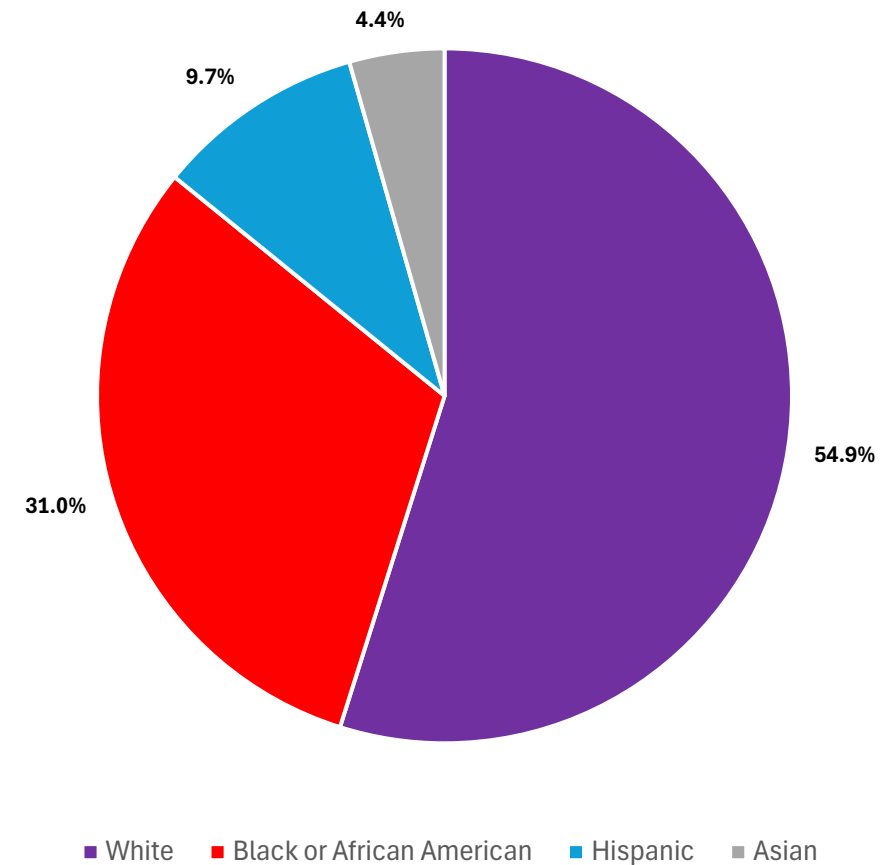

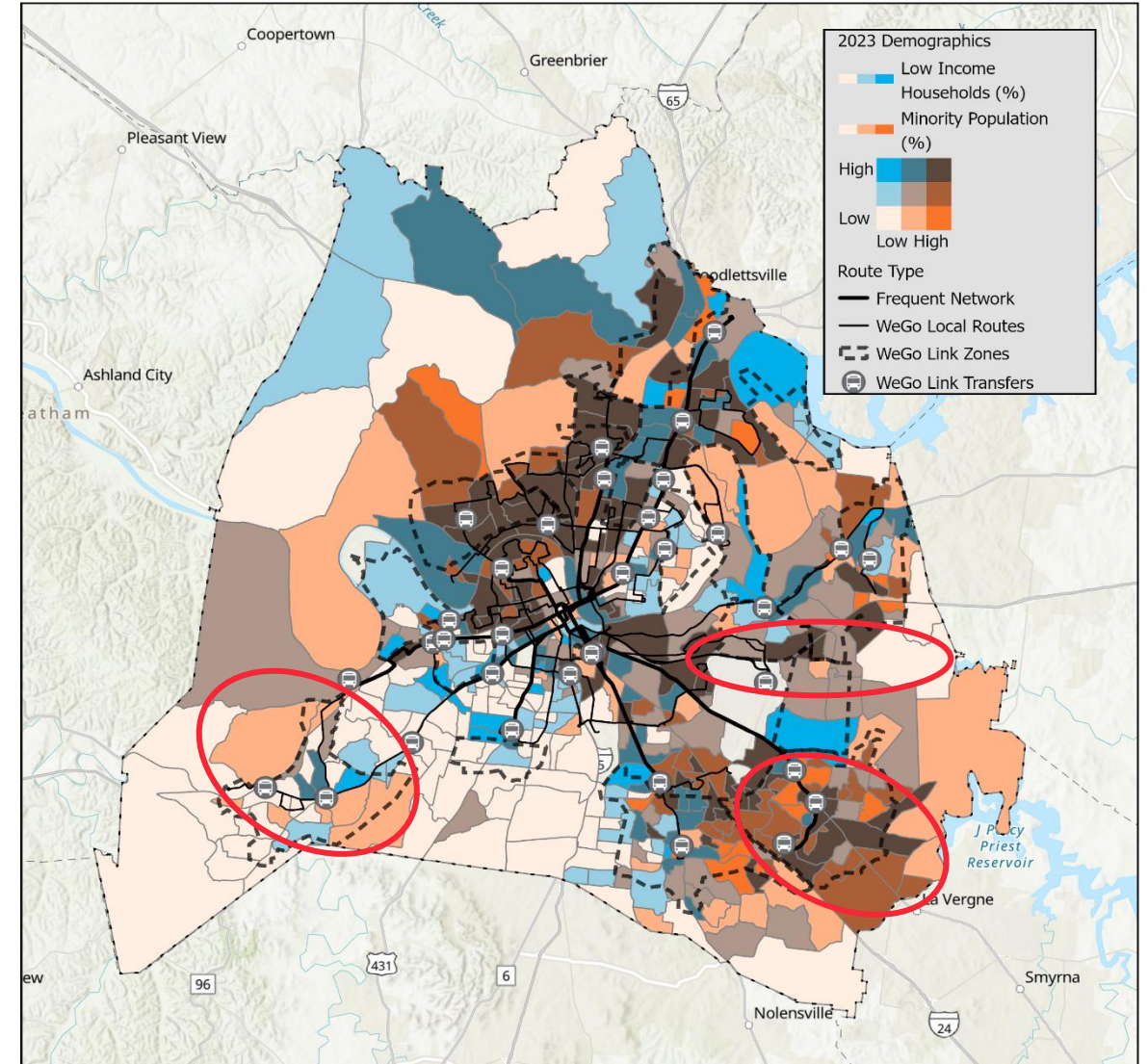
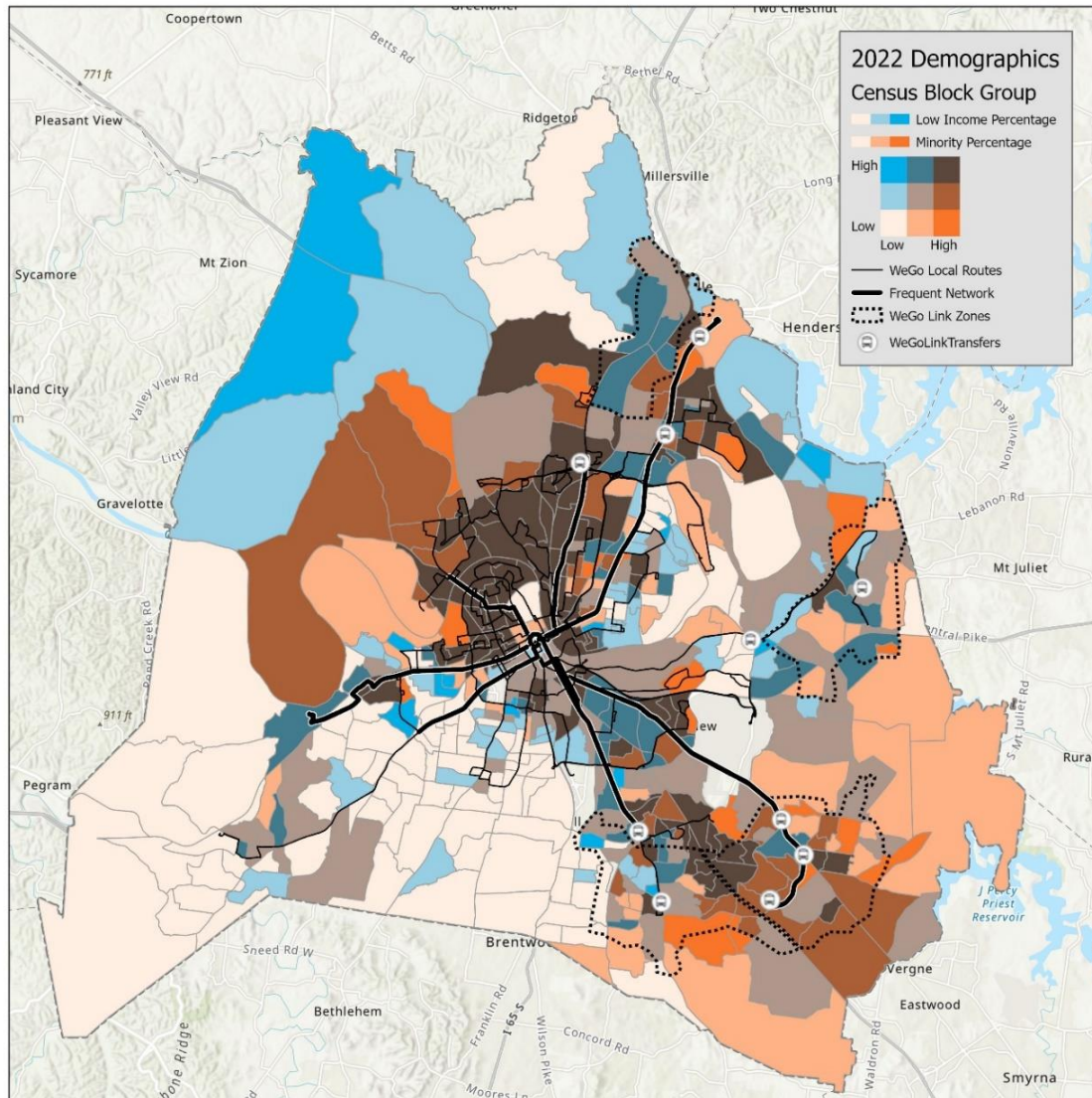


Demographics of RTA Ridership



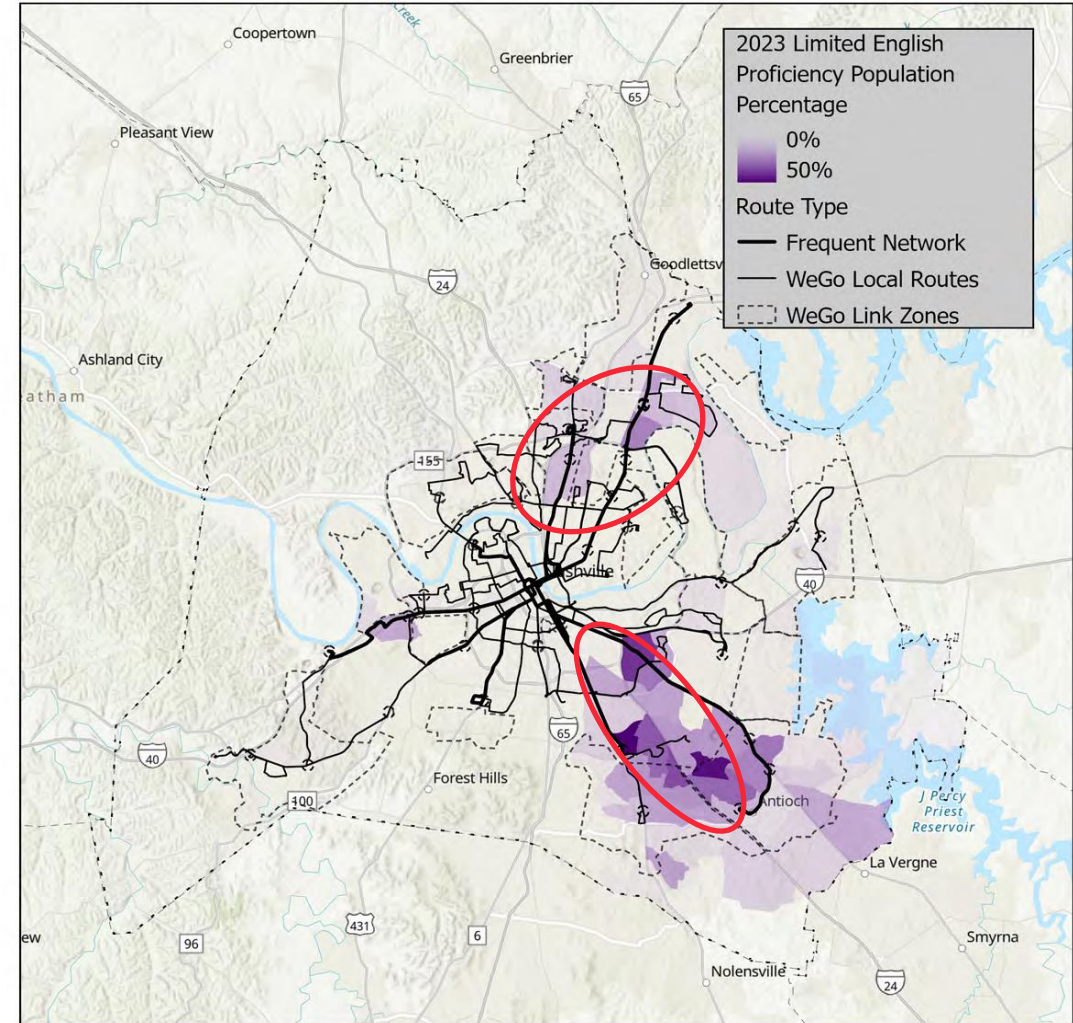
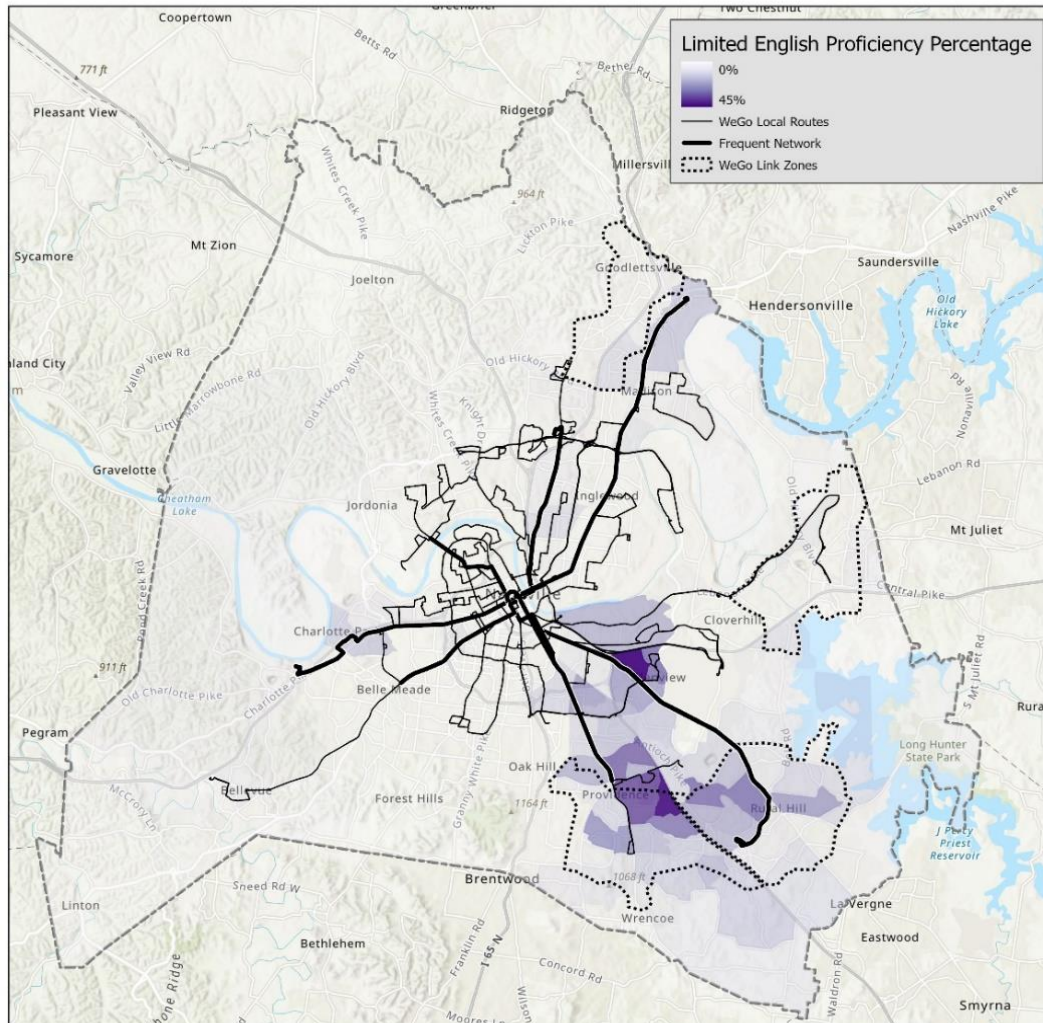

Service and Demographics



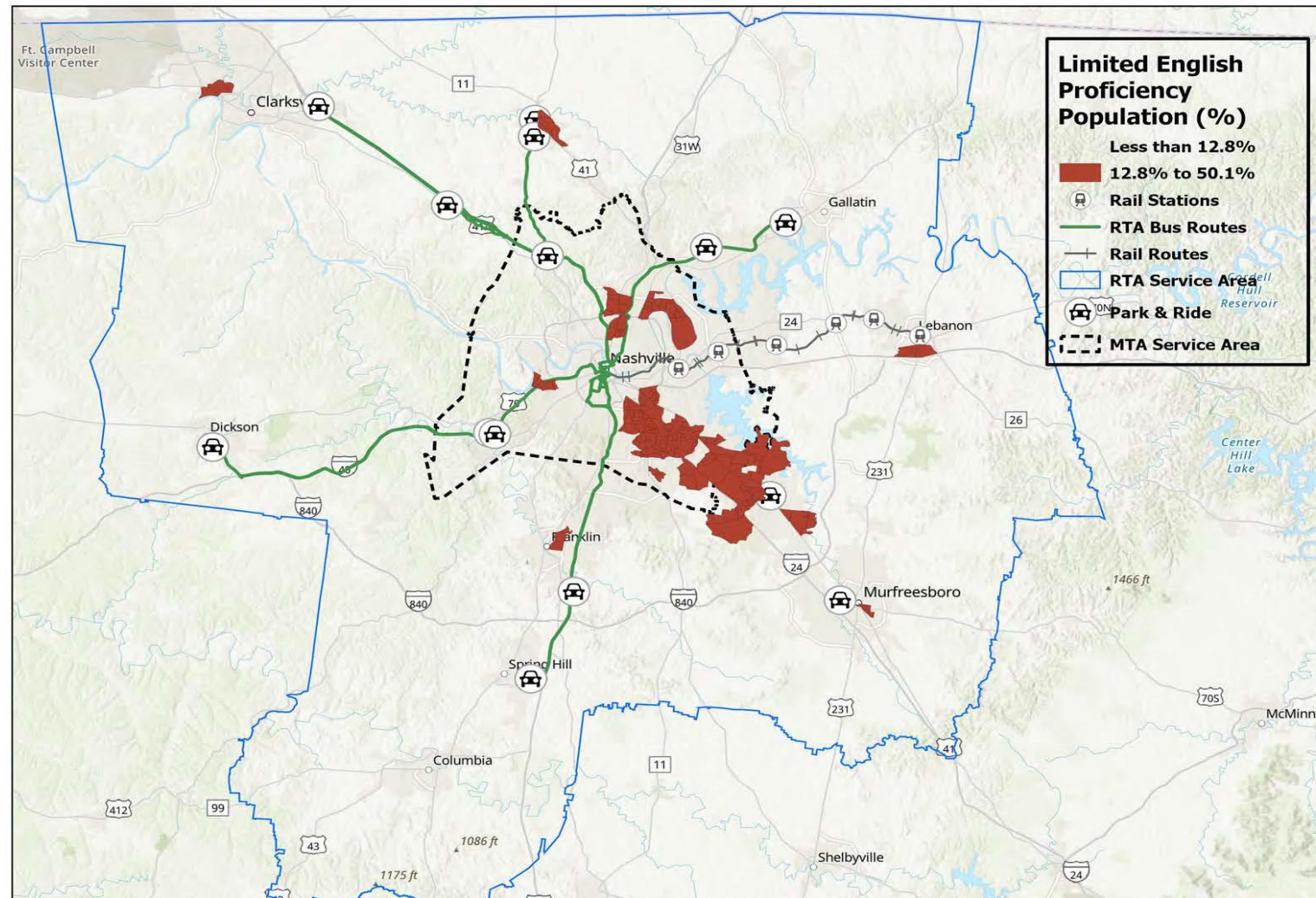
