

Proposed WeGo Link expansion

WeGo is considering expanding its WeGo Link program to include more Nashville neighborhoods. With WeGo Link, riders can get an Uber to a nearby transit stop for just \$2 and then take the bus throughout the county. This fall, WeGo is proposing to expand the pilot program to Hermitage, South Nashville, and Goodlettsville. The public can make comments about this proposal during upcoming public meetings:

- **Thursday, July 21 from 5-6:30 p.m.**, Hermitage Community Center, 3720 James Kay Lane, Hermitage
- **Wednesday, July 27 from 5-6:30 p.m.**, Southeast Community Center (Global Mall at the Crossings), 5260 Hickory Hollow Parkway, unit 202, Antioch
- **Tuesday, August 2 from 4-5:30 p.m.**, Goodlettsville Branch Library, 205 Rivergate Parkway, Goodlettsville

Try out the proposed new WeGo Link zones

WeGo Link will be available in the proposed Hermitage zone on July 21st to allow customers to try out the proposed service. You may use the service to access the public meeting or to connect to fixed route service on this day. All trips must start or end at Hermitage Station or Donelson Station.

For the other public meetings in Goodlettsville and Antioch, the service will also be available on those days.

To use Uber, you'll need to download a voucher here: <https://t.uber.com/WeGoLink>

After downloading the voucher, book an Uber trip as you normally would. As long as your trip starts in the zone and ends at a designated transfer point or starts at a designated transfer point and ends within the zone, you will pay the first \$2 and the voucher will cover the cost of the trip up to \$8.

If you need wheelchair accessibility or are younger than 17 years old, you should contact Mobility Solutions at 615-844-3399 to book a WeGo Link trip within the zone on this day.
